SUBJECT: Methodology Change for the 2020 Roll Approval Process

Beginning with the 2020 roll approval process, the Department of Revenue will modify the basis for roll approval for both in-depth and non-in depth rolls. The Department reviews and approves rolls for two purposes: performance monitoring and indirect equalization of K-12 schools.

For performance monitoring purposes, beginning with the 2020 preliminary roll, the Department will approve in-depth assessment rolls based on the <u>median</u> level of assessment for <u>each stratum studied</u>. The minimum acceptable level of assessment is 0.90.

The Department will approve non-in depth assessment rolls based on an <u>overall value-</u> <u>weighted median</u> level of assessment for all studied strata. The minimum acceptable level of assessment is 0.90.

The Department will continue to calculate the <u>overall value-weighted mean</u> for both in-depth and non-in depth rolls and will transmit that information to the Department of Education for indirect equalization of K-12 schools per section 195.096, F.S. During this transition time, the minimum acceptable levels of assessment for the <u>overall value-weighted mean</u> for both in-depth and non-in depth rolls is also 0.90.

The Department is implementing this change to better align with standards of the International Association of Assessing Officers and to fulfil statutory responsibilities.
