Program Information

The Florida Department of Revenue (Department) is excited to announce the virtual offering of IAAO 101 – Fundamentals of Real Property Appraisal, from the International Association of Assessing Officers (IAAO). The virtual format will enable a diverse set of trainees to participate remotely. Trainees will have opportunities to ask questions, collaborate, share ideas and practice new skills as they would in a traditional classroom. For optimal learning, participants should clear their calendars during course and exam times and attend in a quiet space free from outside distractions.

IAAO 101 Description*

This course is designed to provide students with an understanding and working knowledge of the procedures and techniques required to estimate the market value of vacant and improved properties. This course concentrates on the skills you need to estimate the market value of properties using two approaches to value: the cost approach and the sales comparison approach. Instruction and Testing

Trainees will receive further instructions from IAAO regarding testing. **This is a live course**, and the materials and pace will be like in-person instruction. Your instructor, David Cornell, is highly rated for IAAO courses and delivers a quality course.

The course will be held 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. EDT December 6-9, 2021. The instructor will provide the course schedule. The testing window is December 10-15, 2021. Trainees will attend class using Zoom, and the training link will be in the registration confirmation. A link to the PDF version of the student reference manual will be emailed to registrants from learn@iaao.org. Trainees should print a copy of the student reference manual in advance, unless they have access to dual monitors during the course. Scratch paper and pencils will also be helpful.

Technology Requirements

- A computer with a web camera and microphone is required to take the course and exam.
- A calculator is required.

Prior to the course, students are asked to download Zoom and review the Zoom information on Joining a Meeting.
