MS. FORRESTER: Good morning. My name is

Janice Forrester. I am the Revenue Program

Administrator for the Technical Assistance Section and Property Tax Oversight Program. I will be the moderator for today's workshop. My role as moderator is to preside in a neutral fashion.

Staff from the Department are here today to receive comments on the draft amendment. At this time, I would like staff to introduce themselves.

MS. HARPER: My name is Jenna Harper. I am the Compliance Process Manager with Property Tax Oversight.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Rachel Goldstein and I'm one of the attorneys with the Department.

MR. KELLER: I'm Stephen Keller, I'm one of the attorneys with the Department of Revenue.

MS. DAVIS: I'm Kathryn Davis and I'm also one of the attorneys with the Department of Revenue.

MR. JACKSON: Anthony Jackson, Jr., Senior Tax Specialist.

MS. FORRESTER: Thank you. Today is November 17, 2020 and this is a public rule workshop scheduled under subsection two of section 120.54, Florida Statutes.

The Department is holding this workshop to discuss the draft amendments to rules and forms. The Department published a notice of rule development in the October 28, 2020 edition of the Florida Administrative Register, Volume 46, number 211, pages 4657 through 4659.

For those at the computer, the draft rules and forms are on the Department's proposed rule web page at FloridaRevenue.com/rule. Select the property tax proposed rules drop-down at the bottom of the page. Then select the rule you would like to review.

I'll now ask Anthony Jackson to explain the process that we will use for taking comments on the agenda items. Please note, the Department offices are still temporarily closed to the public. This workshop is taking place using electronic media.

MR. JACKSON: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. If you are attending this workshop using your computer, raise your hand using the icon on the grab-tab to the left of your control panel. We will address you when it's your turn to speak. Please state your name and whom you represent. If you experience difficulty, use the quick-chat option to send me a message.

MS. FORRESTER: Thank you, Anthony.

We will take comments on each agenda item from anyone present or from conference call attendees.

When you speak, please tell us your name and who you represent. We ask that you provide only comments or suggested changes that are directly relevant to the draft. Please hold all other general comments until after we have discussed the

agenda item.

I am now turning the workshop over to Ms. Goldstein to present the draft rules and forms.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Thank you. Good morning, everyone. Today's workshop is intended to discuss the draft rules and forms related to chapter 12-9 for the Department certification program for various certifications, including for property appraisers and tax collectors. So I'm going to go through the rules one by one, explain any changes or improvements and open it up for comments.

These drafts rules are intended to preserve current taxes so the drafts reflect what the Department is currently doing, with the addition of a few updates and program improvements. Before we begin, I kind of just want to do, go over a few highlights of the changes made to these drafts since the last workshop.

The first thing I would point out is that the committees and the current drafts before you reflect the status quo, so the Department's existing use of committees. The second thing is, since the nature of these education courses is to constantly be changing and be in flux, we've decided to not adopt the course (inaudible) into rule. The third thing

is we have expanded our digital accessibility,
making registration, submission of forms and
tuition payment available online. And then lastly
we have removed the continuing education
requirements for staff.

So if you will now turn to the rules, I'll start with the agenda item Rule 12-9.001 entitled Definitions. And here we simply just updated definitions for clarity. So do we have any comments on this rule?

(Pause.)

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that there are no comments on Rule 12-9.001.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Great. Okay. Moving on to Rule 12-9.002, this is just a rule explaining the various certification programs, including the addition of the Certified Cadastralist of Florida into the rule text. Also to provide, the Department will publish an informational guide on the rules themselves and the program overall. That's not going to be promulgated, but it is going to be publicly available. Are there any comments on this rule?

(Pause.)

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record reflect that

we've received no comment on Rule 12-9.002.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. The next is Rule 12-9.003 entitled Oualifications. This rule is just to establish updated qualification criteria and specify the coursework for the professional certification of the property appraisers, tax collectors, their employees and employees with the Department. And it also adds certification criteria for the cadastralist program. Based on a comment we received from the last workshop, we've also incorporated the clarification about unlicensed attendance constituting presence in the classroom. Are there any comments on this particular rule?

(Pause.)

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MS. FORRESTER: Let the record reflect that we've received no comments on Rule 12-9.003.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. Rule 12-9.0031.

Approval of Courses. This particular rule is intended to specify the criteria and the procedures for the approval of courses for credit toward certification, recertification or reinstatement of a professional certification. It also incorporates the use of a new form which we'll cover at the end, for obtaining approval of a course for either

certification or continuing ed. (10:00)

The last workshop we got a few comments about the course approval process and that I just point out that feedback for your consideration. We have also, you know, counted the fact that unavoidable situations might arrive last minute that would require the substitution of either the course itself or an instructor, so we have built in some flexibility to address that concern. Do we have any questions on this rule?

(Pause.)

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record reflect that we've received no comments on Rule 12-9.0031.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. Next, we have
Rule 12-9.0032. This one is Department sponsored
courses and this rule sort of spells out the
procedures for registration, payment, cancellation,
refunds for Department sponsored courses. As I
mentioned earlier, we have tried to implement some
improvements for ease of use and digitize some of
the processes to try to make it easier to do many
of those functions online. So do we have any
comments on that rule?

(Pause.)

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record reflect that

we've received no comments on Rule 12-9.0032.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. Next, we have Rule 12-9.004 entitled Application for Certification. This is just the rule talking about the application process for those applying for the professional certifications, and it incorporates the new application form which we will cover at the end. Do we have any comments?

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that we've received no comments on Rule 12-9.004.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. Rule 12-9.0055. This is the season tuition rule. This clarifies fees associated with obtaining and re-obtaining professional certification. It also explains the payment process for Department sponsored courses via the new online registration and payment portal. Do we have any comments on that rule?

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that we have received no comment on Rule 12-9.0055.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. Rule 12-9.006, this is the certification process. This just clarifies the certification application approval process by the admissions and certifications committee. Do we

1 have any comments on that rule? (Pause.) 2. MS. FORRESTER: Let the record reflect that 3 we've received no comments on Rule 12-9.006. 5 MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. Rule 12-9.007. This is a recertification rule. We've proposed an 6 7 amendment in these drafts related to updates to 8 requirements for all certified professionals to 9 annually certify their government employment and also to acknowledge the Florida Code of Ethics for 10 public officers and employees, and to pay annual 11 recertification fees using our new forms. 12 13 have any comments on this rule? (Pause.) 14 15 MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that we have received no comments on Rule 12-9.007. 16 Okay. Rule 12-9.0077, the 17 MS. GOLDSTEIN: reinstatement rule that specifies procedures for 18 individuals seeking to reinstate their certification 19 20 after it had lapsed. Do we have any comments on this rule? 21 22 (Pause.) 23 MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that we've 24 received no comments on Rule 12-9.0077. 25 MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. And then lastly we have

Rule 12-9.008. We're just repealing this one as unnecessary. Do we have any comments on this rule?

(Pause.)

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that we've received no comments on Rule 12-9.008.

MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. And then lastly we have the two forms in the package. This is in Rule 12D-16.002, Index to Forms. The first form is DR-4001, the Application for Florida Professional Certification. This is our former DR-410. We have amended this form to apply to any applicant for professional certification, annual recertification or for reinstatement. We've also added an acknowledgment of the Florida Code of Ethics for public officers and employees, and the ethics standards set forth in the Florida Constitution.

As I mentioned with our (inaudible) -- we've also updated and improved our online portals so you're able to submit this application and any associated fees online. Do we have any comments on this?

(Pause.)

MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show that we've received no comments for Rule 12D-16.002 or Form DR-4001 or Form DR-4002.

1 MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. That's the last form that I was going to cover, the DR-4002. 2 This is 3 the application for approval of a course for continuing ed credit hours. And as you just 4 5 mentioned, we want to open it up again for comments on that? 6 7 MS. FORRESTER: We can. 8 (Pause.) 9 MS. FORRESTER: Let the record show we have received no comments on Form DR-4002. 10 MS. GOLDSTEIN: Okay. The last four forms, 11 12 the DR-410, DR-516, DR-516E and DR-591, those are 13 all slated for repeal as redundant to the draft DR-4001. So do we have any comments on the repeal 14 15 of those forms? 16 (Pause.) Let the record show that we've 17 MS. FORRESTER: received no comments on the four forms for repeal. 18 MS. GOLDSTEIN: So with that, I will 19 Great. 20 turn it back over to the moderator, Janice 21 Forrester. 22 MS. FORRESTER: Thank you. On behalf of the 23 Department, I want to thank everyone, for 24 participating and sharing your comments with us.
