Changes to Exemption for Motion Picture Educational Entities

Effective July 1, 1999, the exemption from sales and use tax on the purchase or lease of materials or equipment by motion picture educational entities for use in education or demonstration of the school's curriculum was amended to also apply to the **lease or license of real property**. The law now also allows the exemption to be utilized in the **supporting operations** of a motion picture educational entity.

A qualified motion picture educational entity must provide to each vendor at the time of transaction a purchaser's exemption certificate to purchase or lease materials or equipment, or lease or license real property, exempt from sales and use tax. Vendors must retain a copy of this exemption certificate in their records.

SUGGESTED PURCHASER'S EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE FOR ITEMS SOLD OR LEASED; OR REAL PROPERTY LICENSED OR LEASED TO MOTION PICTURE EDUCATIONAL ENTITIES

FOR USE ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1999

The undersigned understands that if such items do not qualify for exemption, the undersigned will be subject to sales and use tax, interest, and penalties. The undersigned further understands that when any person fraudulently, for the purpose of evading tax, issues to a vendor or to any agent of the state a certificate or statement in writing in which he or she claims exemption from the sales tax, such person, in addition to being

liable for payment of the tax plus a mandatory penalty of 200%
of the tax, shall be liable for fine and punishment provided by
law for conviction of a felony of the third degree, as provided
in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
