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New Taxing Jurisdiction Added to Communications Services Tax Effective January 1, 2019

Effective January 1, 2019, the Village of Indiantown in Martin County, and its local communications services tax rate will be added as a local jurisdiction in the state of Florida as follows:

City Name	County Name	Adopted Rate
Indiantown	Martin	5.22%

The new jurisdiction and tax rate are effective for all bills issued on or after January 1, 2019, regardless of the date the service is rendered or transacted. This rate will stay in effect until further notice by the Department.

Indiantown will be added to the communications services tax (CST) return (Form DR-700016, Schedule I, Column A) in alphabetical order within Martin County. Therefore, the order of the jurisdictions within Martin County will change.

If you file your returns using the Department's file and pay website, you will be able to select and add Indiantown when you file your return beginning with the January 2019 reporting period.

If you file using electronic data interchange (EDI), you should add the following code in your file to represent Indiantown when you transmit your CST returns:

City Name	Code for E-filing
Indiantown	ZIDT

The feature ID code the Department will use for Indiantown within the Address/Jurisdiction Database is 2791523.
