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## SALES AND USE TAX

Sales and Use Tax collections were below the estimate in April 2016 by \$13.2m (0.5%) and over the 2015 April collections by \$111.4m (4.7%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


### CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$316.2m in April 2016 were above the estimates by \$4.5m (1.4%) and below the 2015 April collections by \$9.8m (3.0%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

### **DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX**

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were below the estimate by \$32.8m (15.1%) in April 2016 and below the 2015 April collections by \$6.5m (3.4%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 GR conference (page 5).


### SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN April 2016 of \$2,509.4m were \$13.2m (0.5%) below the estimates. The April 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$111.4m (4.7%) above the April 2015 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference.

# Analysis of March collections by category...

Four categories were below the estimates in March 2016, Other Consumer Durables being the weakest (5.4%), followed by Consumer Non-Durables (4.4%). Business Investment and Tourism categories were above the estimates. Compared to March 2015, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Business Investment being the strongest (14.0%), followed by Construction (11.9%) and Auto-Related (8.9%).

Note: March 2016 sales tax collections by categories reflect February 2015 activity.






### **CORPORATE INCOME TAX....**

.... Collections of \$316.2m in April 2016 were \$4.5m (1.4%) above the April estimates. The April 2016 CIT collections were \$9.8m (3.0%) below the April 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference.





### OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$977.4m to DOR tax collections in April 2016, which were \$22.2m (2.2%) below the estimates. The April 2016 collections were \$3.3 (0.3%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamp collections were \$32.8 (15.1%) below the estimates. The Doc Stamp collections in April 2016 were \$6.5m (3.4%) below the April 2015 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in April was below the estimate by \$1.7m (6.0%). Compared to the April 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 2.9% above.

The April collections of \$357.6m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$17.3m (5.1%) above the estimates. Compared to April 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the April 2016 collections were \$17.7m (5.2%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$7.5m (5.2%) above the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in April 2016 were \$4.4m (9.0%) below the estimates, and were 9.1% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$9.4m (5.1%) below the estimates in April 2016.
