## SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in April 2019 by $\$ 52.1 \mathrm{~m}$ (1.7\%) and above the April 2018 collections by \$187m (6.6\%). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).

## CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of $\$ 633.4 \mathrm{~m}$ in April 2019 were above the estimate by $\$ 191 \mathrm{~m}$ (43.2\%) and over the April 2018 collections by $\$ 200.9 \mathrm{~m}$ (46.4\%). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX
Documentary Stamp Tax collections of $\$ 248.8 \mathrm{~m}$ were less than the estimate in April 2019 by $\$ 6 \mathrm{~m}$ (-2.4\%) and above the April 2018 collections by $\$ 20.7 \mathrm{~m}$ (9.1\%). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference (page 5).

## Analysis of March collections by category...

Three categories were above the estimates in March 2019, with Construction ( $15.4 \%$ ) above, Business Investment ( $1.1 \%$ ) above, and Other Consumer Durables ( $0.1 \%$ ) above. Auto-Related was ( $-3 \%$ ) below, Consumer Non-Durables (-3\%) below, and Tourism \& Rec. (-0.6\%) below. Compared to March 2018, all categories were above the same month collections last year. The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR.

Note: March 2019 sales tax collections by categories reflect February 2019 activity.
.. COLLECTIONS IN April 2019 of \$3,033.5m were $\$ 52.1 \mathrm{~m}(1.7 \%)$ above the estimate. The April 2019 Sales and Use Tax collections were $\$ 187 \mathrm{~m}$ (6.6\%) above the April 2018 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference.

## CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

## OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax, other taxes contributed $\$ 1102.6 \mathrm{~m}$ to DOR tax collections in April 2019, which were $\$ 3.2 \mathrm{~m}(-0.3 \%)$ below the estimate. The April 2019 collections were $\$ 28.7 \mathrm{~m}$ (2.7\%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in April 2019 were $\$ 6 \mathrm{~m}(-2.4 \%)$ below the estimate. Compared to April 2018 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the April 2019 collections were $\$ 20.7 \mathrm{~m}$ ( $9.1 \%$ ) above

The collections of the Communications Services Tax in April were below the estimate by $\$ 14.6 \mathrm{~m}$ ( $-10.6 \%$ ). Compared to April 2018 collections on Communication Services Tax, the April 2019 collections were $\$ 23 \mathrm{~m}$ (-15.8\%) below. The collections of Insurance Premium Tax in April were above the estimate by $\$ 21.3 \mathrm{~m}$ (10.4\%). Compared to April 2018 collections on Insurance Premium Taxes, the April 2019 collections were $\$ 21.9 \mathrm{~m}$ (10.8\%) above. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes \& Fees in April were below the estimate by $\$ 0.6 \mathrm{~m}(-0.2 \%)$. The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were $\$ 1.6 \mathrm{~m}$ (4.7\%) above.

## HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS

Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in March 2019. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
