## SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in June 2019 by $\$ 58.9 \mathrm{~m}(2.2 \%)$ and above the June 2018 collections by $\$ 237.3 \mathrm{~m}$ (9.6\%). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).

## CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of $\$ 551.8 \mathrm{~m}$ in June 2019 were above the estimate by $\$ 31.8 \mathrm{~m}$ ( $6.1 \%$ ) and over the June 2018 collections by $\$ 28.6 \mathrm{~m}$ (5.5\%). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX
Documentary Stamp Tax collections of $\$ 252.1 \mathrm{~m}$ were greater than the estimate in June 2019 by $\$ 2.6 \mathrm{~m}$ (1.1\%) and above the June 2018 collections by $\$ 14 \mathrm{~m}$ (5.9\%). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference (page 5).

## SALES TAX ...

.. COLLECTIONS IN June 2019 of $\$ 2,704.2 \mathrm{~m}$ were $\$ 58.9 \mathrm{~m}(2.2 \%)$ above the estimate. The June 2019 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$237.3m (9.6\%) above the June 2018 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference.

Analysis of May collections by category...

Four categories were above the estimates in May 2019, with Consumer Non-Durables (10.1\%) above, Business Investment (5.5\%) above, Auto-Related (3.1\%) above, and Construction (2.1\%) above. Other Consumer Durables was (-2\%) below, and Tourism \& Rec. (-0.2\%) below. Compared to May 2018, five categories were below the same month collections last year, Construction being the strongest at 3.3\% above, while Other Consumer Durables was the weakest at ( $-13.6 \%$ ). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR.

... COLLECTIONS of $\$ 551.8 \mathrm{~m}$ in June 2019 were above the estimate by $\$ 31.8 \mathrm{~m}$ ( $6.1 \%$ ) and over the June 2018 collections by $\$ 28.6 \mathrm{~m}$ ( $5.5 \%$ ). The estimates are based on the March 14, 2019 GR conference (page 4).



## OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax, other taxes contributed $\$ 1091.1 \mathrm{~m}$ to DOR tax collections in June 2019, which were $\$ 2.1 \mathrm{~m}(0.2 \%)$ above the estimate. The June 2019 collections were $\$ 71.9 \mathrm{~m}(7.1 \%)$ above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in June 2019 were $\$ 2.6 \mathrm{~m}$ ( $1.1 \%$ ) above the estimate. Compared to June 2018 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the June 2019 collections were $\$ 14 \mathrm{~m}(5.9 \%)$ above

The collections of the Communications Services Tax in June were below the estimate by $\$ 11.9 \mathrm{~m}(-8.2 \%)$. Compared to June 2018 collections on Communication Services Tax, the June 2019 collections were $\$ 8 \mathrm{~m}$ (-5.6\%) below. The collections of Insurance Premium Tax in June were above the estimate by $\$ 5.4 \mathrm{~m}(2.6 \%)$. Compared to June 2018 collections on Insurance Premium Taxes, the June 2019 collections were $\$ 19.5 \mathrm{~m}$ (10.2\%) above. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes \& Fees in June were above the estimate by $\$ 1.3 \mathrm{~m}(0.3 \%)$. The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were $\$ 1 \mathrm{~m}(2.8 \%)$ above.

## HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS

Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in March 2019. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
