SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in September 2016 by \$11.0m (0.5%) and over the 2015 September collections by \$150.7m (7.7%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$438.4m in September 2016 were above the estimates by \$53.8m (14.0%) and above the 2015 September collections by \$69.5m (18.8%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$184.4m were right on the target with the estimate in September 2016 and below the 2015 September collections by \$13.0m (6.6%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 GR conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN September 2016 of \$2,115.8m were \$11.0m (0.5%) above the estimates. The September 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$150.7m (7.7%) above the September 2015 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 REC conference.

Analysis of August collections by category...

Tourism was the only category above the estimates in August 2016 (1.4%). Five categories were below the estimates, Other Consumer Durables being the weakest (7.6%) followed by Construction (5.5%). Compared to August 2015, five categories were above the same month collections last year, Tourism being the strongest (5.8%), followed by Construction (5.3%). Other Consumer Durables were below the estimates by 1.2%.

Note: August 2016 sales tax collections by categories reflect July 2016 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$438.4m in September 2016 were \$53.8m (14.0%) above the September estimates. The September 2016 CIT collections were \$69.5m (18.8%) above the September 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$780.3m to DOR tax collections in September 2016, which were \$2.8m (0.4%) above the estimates. The September 2016 collections were \$3.4m (0.4%) below the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp collections in September 2016 were right on the target with the estimates. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in September was above the estimate by \$2.5m (9.3%). Compared to the September 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$1.9m above.

The September collections of \$326.3m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$4.9m (1.5%) below the estimates. Compared to September 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the September 2016 collections were \$3.3m (1.0%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$5.5m (3.8%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in September 2016 were \$3.1m (5.2%) above the estimates, and were 0.7% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$6.1m above the estimates in September 2016.
