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SALES AND USE TAX

Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in September 2018 by \$91.6m (4%) and above the September 2017 collections by \$179.2m (8.1%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).

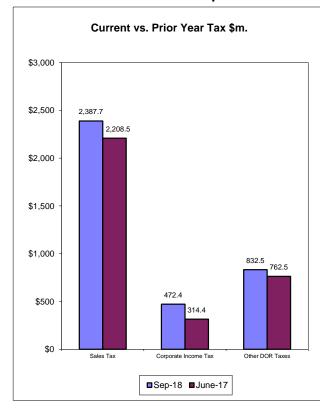
CORPORATE INCOME TAX

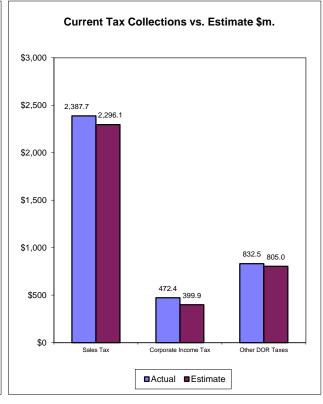
CIT collections of \$472.4m in September 2018 were above the estimate by \$72.5m (18.1%) and over the September 2017 collections by \$158m (50.3%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$206.6m were greater than the estimate in September 2018 by \$21.8m (11.8%) and above the September 2017 collections by \$54.6m (35.9%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference (page 5).

SALES TAX ...

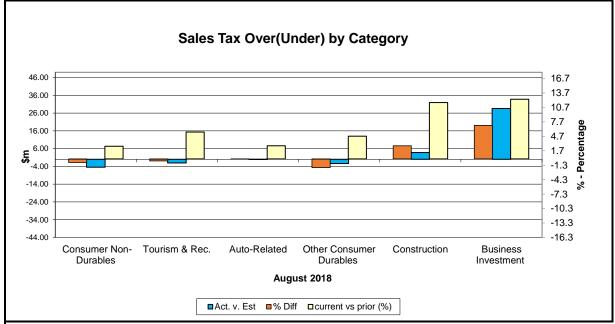
... COLLECTIONS IN September 2018 of \$2,387.7m were \$91.6m (4%) above the estimate. The September 2018 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$179.2m (8.1%) above the September 2017 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are

based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference.

Analysis of July collections by category...

Four categories were below the estimates in August 2018, with Other Consumer Durables (-1.8%) below, Consumer Non-Durables (-0.7%) below, Tourism & Rec. (-0.4%) below, and Auto-Related (-0%) below. Business Investment was (7%) above, and Construction (2.7%) above. Compared to August 2017, all categories were above the same month collections last year. The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference.

Note: August 2018 sales tax collections by categories reflect July 2018 activity.

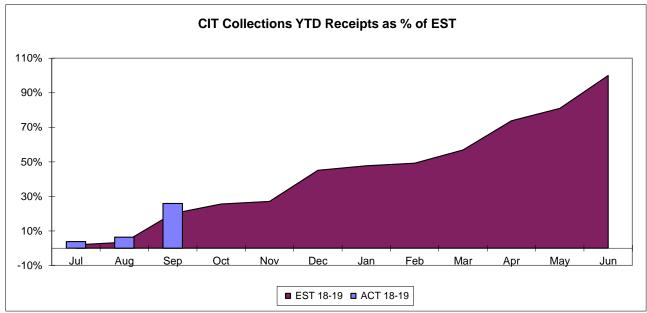


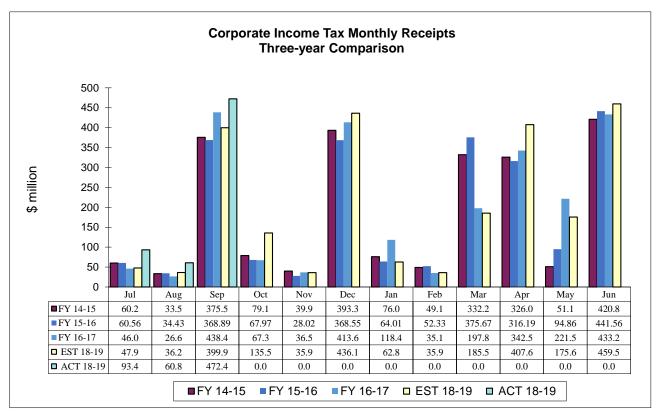

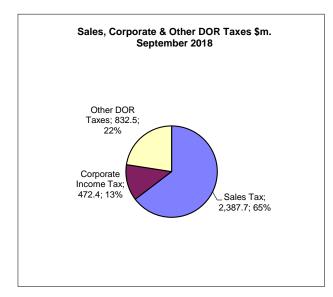


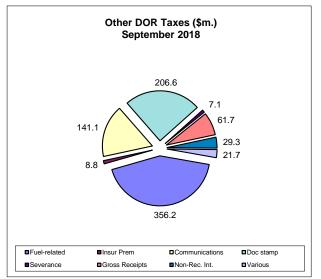


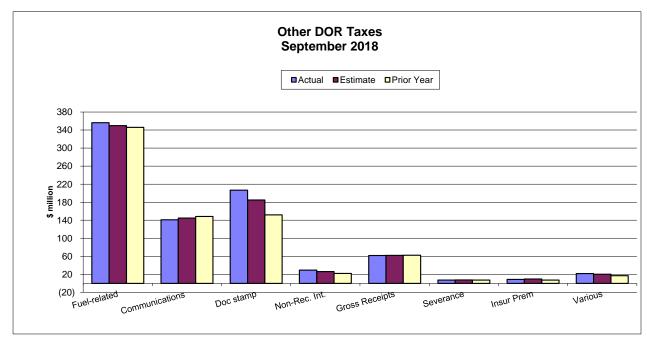
OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax, other taxes contributed \$832.5m to DOR tax collections in September 2018, which were \$27.5m (3.4%) above the estimate. The September 2018 collections were \$70m (9.2%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in September 2018 were \$21.8m (11.8%) above the estimate. Compared to September 2017 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the September 2018 collections were \$54.6m (35.9%) above

The collections of the Communications Services Tax in September were below the estimate by \$3.7m (-2.6%). Compared to September 2017 collections on Communication Services Tax, the September 2018 collections were \$7.3m (-4.9%) below. The collections of Insurance Premium Tax in September were below the estimate by \$0.9m (-9.1%). Compared to September 2017 collections on Insurance Premium Taxes, the September 2018 collections were \$1.5m (20.4%) above. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes & Fees in September were above the estimate by \$6.4m (1.8%). The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$3.1m (12%) above.







HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS	
Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in August 2018 . These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
