SALES AND USE TAX

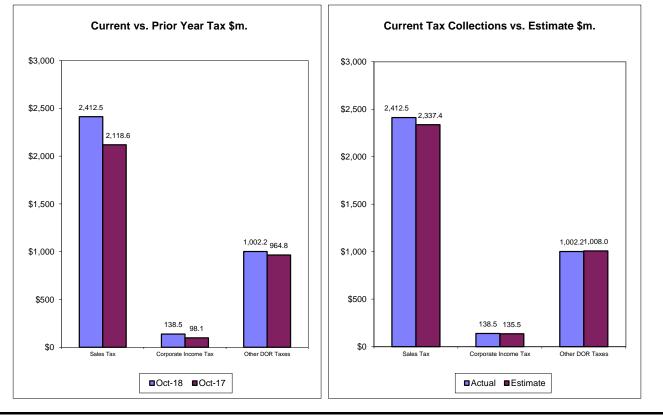
Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in October 2018 by \$75.1m (3.2%) and above the October 2017 collections by \$293.9m (13.9%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).

CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of \$138.5m in October 2018 were above the estimate by \$3m (2.2%) and over the October 2017 collections by \$40.4m (41.1%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$238.1m were greater than the estimate in October 2018 by \$14.4m (6.4%) and above the October 2017 collections by \$26.8m (12.7%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference (page 5).

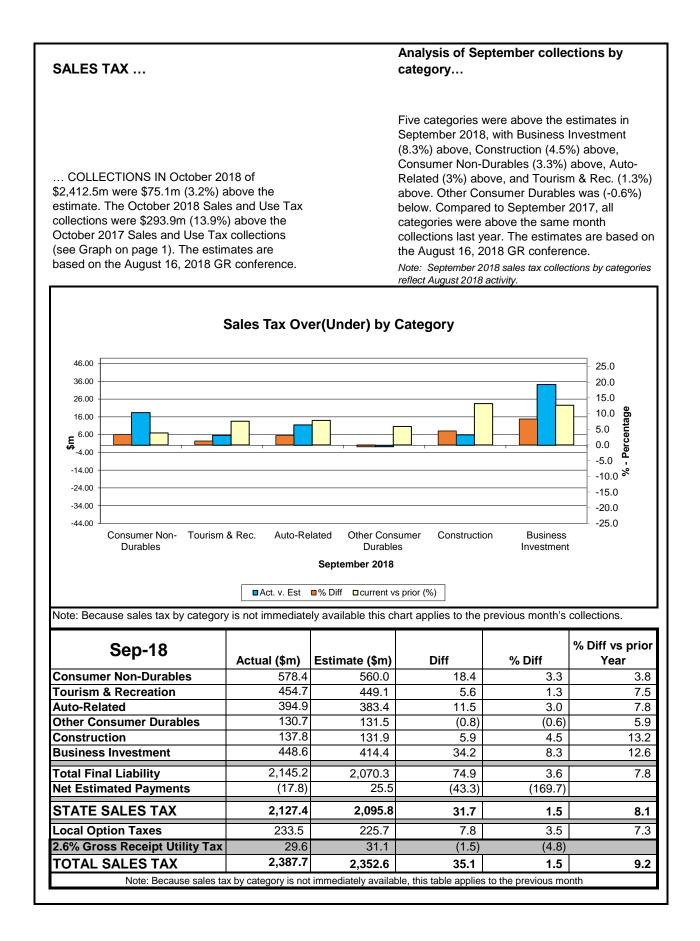

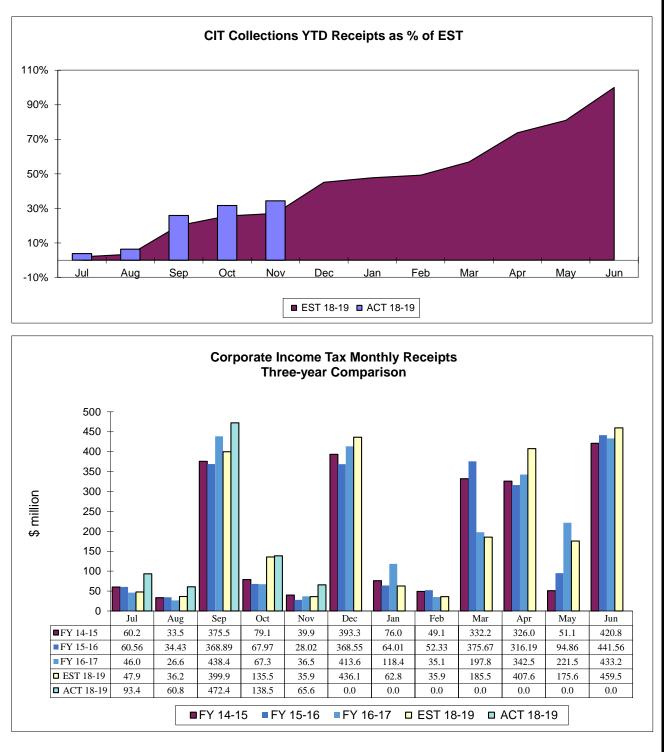

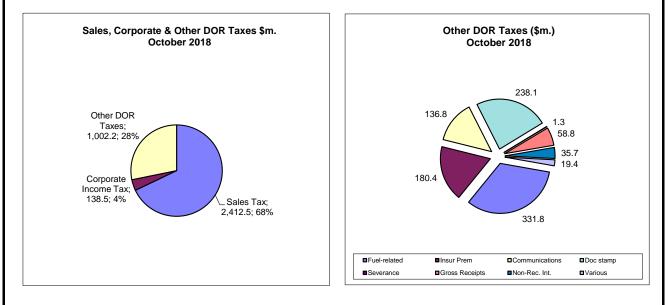
CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

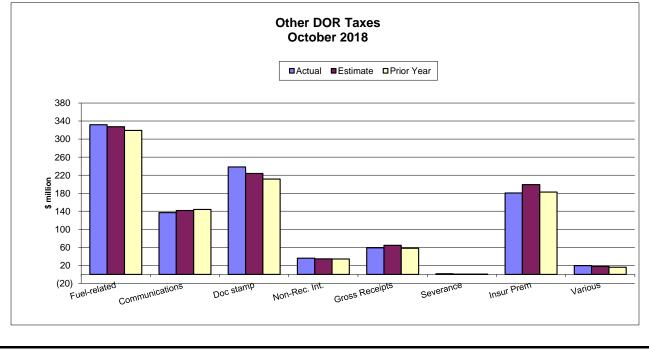


... COLLECTIONS of \$138.5m in October 2018 were above the estimate by \$3m (2.2%) and over the October 2017 collections by \$40.4m (41.1%). The estimates are based on the August 16, 2018 GR conference (page 4).

OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax, other taxes contributed \$1002.2m to DOR tax collections in October 2018, which were \$5.8m (-0.6%) below the estimate. The October 2018 collections were \$37.4m (3.9%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in October 2018 were \$14.4m (6.4%) above the estimate. Compared to October 2017 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the October 2018 collections were \$26.8m (12.7%) above The collections of the Communications Services Tax in October were below the estimate by \$4.8m (-3.4%). Compared to October 2017 collections on Communication Services Tax, the October 2018 collections were \$7m (-4.9%) below. The collections of Insurance Premium Tax in October were below the estimate by \$18.6m (-9.4%). Compared to October 2017 collections on Insurance Premium Taxes, the October 2018 collections were \$2.1m (-1.2%) below. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes & Fees in October were above the estimate by \$4.4m (1.3%). The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$1.3m (3.8%) above.





HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS

Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in <u>August 2018</u>. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
