SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were below the estimate in November 2016 by \$51.0m (2.4%) and over the 2015 November collections by \$25.6m (1.2%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$36.5m in November 2016 were below the estimates by \$3.9m (9.6%) and above the 2015 November collections by \$8.5m (30.4%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$203.7m were below the estimate in November 2016 by \$10.0m (4.7%) and above the 2015 November collections by \$29.7m (17.0%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 GR conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN November 2016 of \$2,120.7m were \$51.0m (2.4%) below the estimates. The November 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$25.6m (1.2%) above the November 2015 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The year to date collections for five months were \$25.0m above the five months' estimates. The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 REC conference.

Analysis of October collections by category...

Four categories were above the estimates in October 2016, Auto-Related being the strongest (5.0%) followed by Other Consumer Durables (2.7%). Consumer Non-Durables and Construction were below the estimate (4.8% & 1.9%). Compared to October 2015, Five categories were above the same month collections last year, Business Investment being the strongest (7.1%), followed by Tourism (6.0%). Consumer Non-Durables were below the same month prior year's collections.

Note: October 2016 sales tax collections by categories reflect September 2016 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$36.5m in November 2016 were \$3.9m (9.6%) below the November estimates. The November 2016 CIT collections were \$8.5m (30.4%) above the November 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$778.5m to DOR tax collections in November 2016, which were \$14.1m (1.8%) below the estimates. The November 2016 collections were \$20.3m (2.7%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp collections in November 2016 were \$10.0m (4.7%) below the estimates. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in November was above the estimate by \$1.1m (3.5%). Compared to the November 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$7.1m (27.8%) above.

The November collections of \$333.1m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$0.7m (0.2%) above the estimates. Compared to November 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the November 2016 collections were \$8.8m (2.7%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$4.4m (3.2%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in October 2016 were \$1.7m (3.1%) below the estimates, and were 0.7% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$0.6m below the estimates in November 2016.
