SALES AND USE TAX

Severance Taxes15

Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in December 2016 by \$0.8m (0.04%) and over the 2015 December collections by \$116.3m (5.4%). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$413.6m in December 2016 were above the estimates by \$71.1m (20.7%) and above the 2015 December collections by \$15.0m (12.2%). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$203.7m were above the estimate in December 2016 by \$13.8m (7.3%) and below the 2015 December collections by \$0.2m (0.1%). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 GR conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN December 2016 of \$2,289.8m were \$0.8m (0.04%) above the estimates. The December 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$116.3m (5.4%) above the December 2015 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 REC conference.

Analysis of November collections by category...

Five categories were below the estimates in November 2016, Other Consumer Durables being the weakest (3.8%) followed by Business Investment (3.5%). The collections of Consumer Non-Durables were above the estimate by \$24.5m (4.5%). Compared to November 2015, four categories were above the same month collections last year, Consumer Non-Durables being the strongest (7.3%). Other Consumer Durables were below the same month prior year's collections by 2%.

Note: November 2016 sales tax collections by categories reflect October 2016 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$413.6m in December 2016 were \$71.1m (20.7%) above the December estimates. The December 2016 CIT collections were \$15.0m (12.2%) above the December 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$782.8m to DOR tax collections in December 2016, which were \$21.3m (2.8%) above the estimates. The December 2016 collections were \$23.5m (3.1%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp collections in December 2016 were \$13.8m (7.3%) above the estimates. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in December was above the estimate by \$2.6m (8.8%). Compared to the December 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$4.0m (14.4%) above.

The December collections of \$329.6m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$4.3m (1.3%) above the estimates. Compared to December 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the December 2016 collections were \$16.9m (5.4%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$0.5m (0.4%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in December 2016 were \$0.8m (1.7%) below the estimates, and were 6.8% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$0.7m below the estimates in December 2016.
