SALES AND USE TAX

Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in December 2019 by \$64m (2.4%) and above the December 2018 collections by \$186m (7.2%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2019 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$393.7m in December 2019 were above the estimate by \$25.4m (6.9%) and under the December 2018 collections by \$60.4m (-13.3%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2019 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$259.1m were greater than the estimate in December 2019 by \$9.4m (3.8%) and above the December 2018 collections by \$47.5m (22.4%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2019 GR conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN December 2019 of \$2,775.4m were \$64m (2.4%) above the estimate. The December 2019 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$186m (7.2%) above the December 2018 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2019 GR conference.

Analysis of November collections by category...

Three categories were above the estimates in November 2019, with Other Consumer Durables (3.7%) above, Auto-Related (1.7%) above, and Consumer Non-Durables (0.9%) above. Construction was (-8.8%) below, Tourism & Rec. (-1%) below, and Business Investment (-0.5%) below. Compared to November 2018, five categories were above the same month collections last year, Consumer Non-Durables being the strongest at 7.2% above, while Construction was the weakest at (-24.1%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2019 GR. *Note: November 2019 sales tax collections by categories*






... COLLECTIONS of \$393.7m in December 2019 were above the estimate by \$25.4m (6.9%) and under the December 2018 collections by \$60.4m (-13.3%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2019 GR conference (page 4).








OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax, other taxes contributed \$875m to DOR tax collections in December 2019, which were \$9m (-1%) below the estimate. The December 2019 collections were \$31.2m (3.7%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in December 2019 were \$9.4m (3.8%) above the estimate. Compared to December 2018 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the December 2019 collections were \$47.5m (22.4%) above.

The collections of the Communications Services Tax in December were below the estimate by \$8.5m (-5.9%). Compared to December 2018 collections on Communication Services Tax, the December 2019 collections were \$2.1m (-1.5%) below. The collections of Insurance Premium Tax in December were above the estimate by \$4.5m (413.1%). Compared to December 2018 collections on Insurance Premium Taxes, the December 2019 collections were \$5m (747.6%) above. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes & Fees in December were below the estimate by \$4.2m (-1.2%). The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$8.7m (24.9%) above.
