SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in January 2016 by \$26.2m (1.0%) and over the 2015 January collections by \$155.8m (6.5%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$64.0m in January 2016 were below the estimates by \$14.5m (18.5%) and below the 2015 January collections by \$12.0m (15.8%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were below the estimate by \$5.3m (2.8%) in January 2016 and above the 2015 January collections by \$32.7m (21.7%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN January 2016 of \$2,571.4m were \$26.2m (1.0%) above the estimates. The January 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$155.8m (6.5%) above the January 2015 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference.

Analysis of December collections by category...

Two categories were above the estimates in December 2015, Business Investment being the strongest (0.5%) followed by Tourism (0.2%). Four categories were below the estimates, Other Consumer Durables was the weakest (6.4%) followed by Auto-Related Category (1.4%). Compared to December 2014, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Auto-Related being the strongest (8.8%) followed by Construction (8.7%) and Business Investment (8.5%).

Note: December 2015 sales tax collections by categories reflect November 2015 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$64.0m in January 2016 were \$14.5m (18.5%) below the January estimates. The January 2016 CIT collections were \$12.0 million (15.8%) below the January 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$768.0m to DOR tax collections in January 2016, which were \$8.6m (1.1%) above the estimates. The January 2016 collections were \$49.2m (4.9%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$5.3m (2.8%) below the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in January 2016 were \$32.7m (21.7%) above the January 2015 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in January was above the estimate by \$0.3m (1.0%). Compared to the January 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 23.2% above.

The January collections of \$325.5m on Fuel Related Taxes were right on the target. Compared to January 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the January 2016 collections were \$19.2m (6.3%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$8.9m (6.2%) above the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in January 2016 were \$3.3m (7.1%) above the estimates, and were 0.6% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$0.6m below the estimates in January 2016.
