SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in February 2017 by \$9.3m (0.4%) and over the 2016 February collections by \$167.8m (8.0%). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$35.1m in February 2017 were below the estimates by \$0.7m (2.0%) and below the 2016 February collections by \$17.2m (32.9%). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$176.4m were above the estimate in February 2017 by \$6.9m (4.1%) and above the 2016 February collections by \$4.0m (2.3%). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 GR conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN February 2017 of \$2,277.8m were \$9.3m (0.4%) above the estimates. The February 2017 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$167.8m (8.0%) above the February 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 REC conference.

Analysis of January collections by category...

Three categories were above the estimates in January 2017, Construction being the Strongest (2.2%) followed by Auto-Related (1.7%). Three Categories were below the estimates, Other Consumer Durables being the weakest (4.7%) followed by Consumer Non-Durables (1.7%). Compared to January 2016, five categories were above the same month collections last year, Auto-Related being the strongest (7.7%). Constructions were below the same month prior year's collections by 4.2%.

Note: January 2017 sales tax collections by categories reflect December 2016 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$35.1m in February 2017 were \$0.7m (2.0%) below the February estimates. The February 2017 CIT collections were \$17.2m (32.9%) below the February 2016 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the December 12, 2016 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$837.2m to DOR tax collections in February 2017, which were \$26.2m (3.0%) below the estimates. The February 2017 collections were \$27.8m (3.2%) below the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp collections in February 2017 were \$6.9m (4.1%) above the estimates. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in February was below the estimate by \$0.1m (0.6%). Compared to the February 2016's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$1.7m (6.4%) below.

The February collections of \$326.1m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$11.3m (3.4%) below the estimates. Compared to February 2016 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the February 2017 collections were \$2.9m (0.9%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$1.4m (1.0%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in February 2017 were \$2.4m (4.9%) below the estimates, and were 2.6% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$17.1m below the estimates in February 2017.
