SALES AND USE TAX

Sales and Use Tax collections were below the estimate in March 2016 by \$0.09m (0.0%) and over the 2015 March collections by \$121.3m (5.76%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$375.7m in March 2016 were above the estimates by \$66.6m (21.5%) and above the 2015 March collections by \$43.4m (13.08%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were below the estimate by \$23.6m (11.6%) in March 2016 and below the 2015 March collections by \$10.8m (5.63%). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 GR conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN March 2016 of \$2,227.8m were \$0.09m (0.0%) below the estimates. The March 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$121.3m (5.76%) above the March 2015 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference.

Analysis of February collections by category...

The six categories were below the estimates in February 2016, the weakest being Other Consumer Durables was the weakest (12.6%), followed by Construction (4.9%). Compared to February 2015, only four categories were above the same month collections last year, Business Investment being the strongest (6.3%), followed by Construction (4.0%). The two categories below the February 2015 numbers are Other Consumer Durables (4.5%) and Consumer Non-Durables (0.2%).

Note: February 2016 sales tax collections by categories reflect January 2015 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$375.7m in March 2016 were \$66.6m (21.5%) above the February estimates. The March 2016 CIT collections were \$43.4m (13.08%) above the March 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the January 19, 2016 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$815.8m to DOR tax collections in March 2016, which were \$6.7m (0.8%) below the estimates. The March 2016 collections were \$4.5 (0.5%) below the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamp collections were \$23.6 (11.6%) below the estimates. The Doc Stamp collections in March 2016 were \$10.8m (5.63%) below the March 2015 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in March was below the estimate by \$1.5m (5.2%). Compared to the March 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 1.63% below.

The March collections of \$322.8m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$25.1m (8.4%) above the estimates. Compared to March 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the March 2016 collections were \$25.4m (8.55%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$3.8m (2.7%) above the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in February 2016 were \$2.1m (4.5%) above the estimates, and were 3.1% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$16.4m (21.5%) below the estimates in March 2016.
