## SALES AND USE TAX

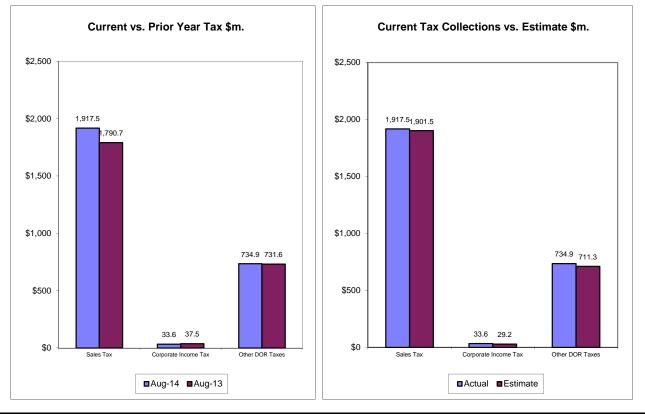
Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in August by \$16.0m (0.8%) and over the 2013 August collections by \$126.8m (7.1%). The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).

## CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of \$33.6m in August were above the estimate by \$4.4m (15.2%) and below the 2013 August collections by \$3.9m. The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference (page 4).

## DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were above the estimate by \$18.0m (12.2%) in August and stays at the same level as 2013 August collections at \$165.3m. The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference (page 5).



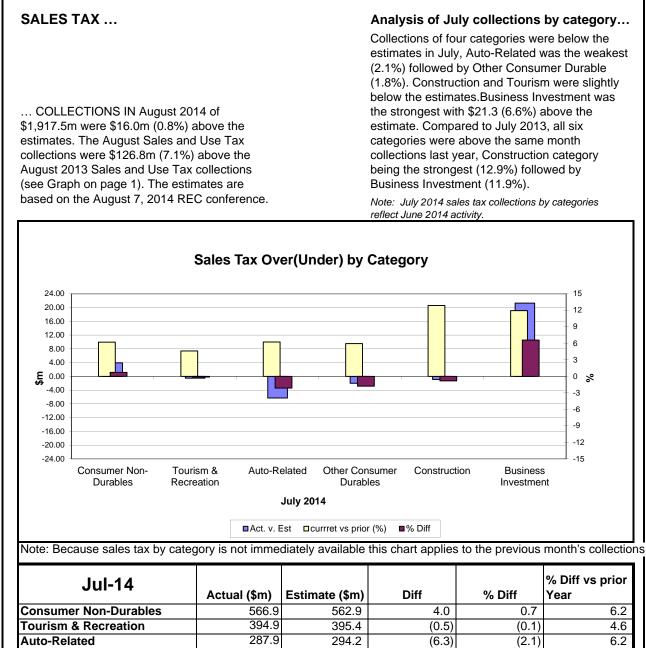

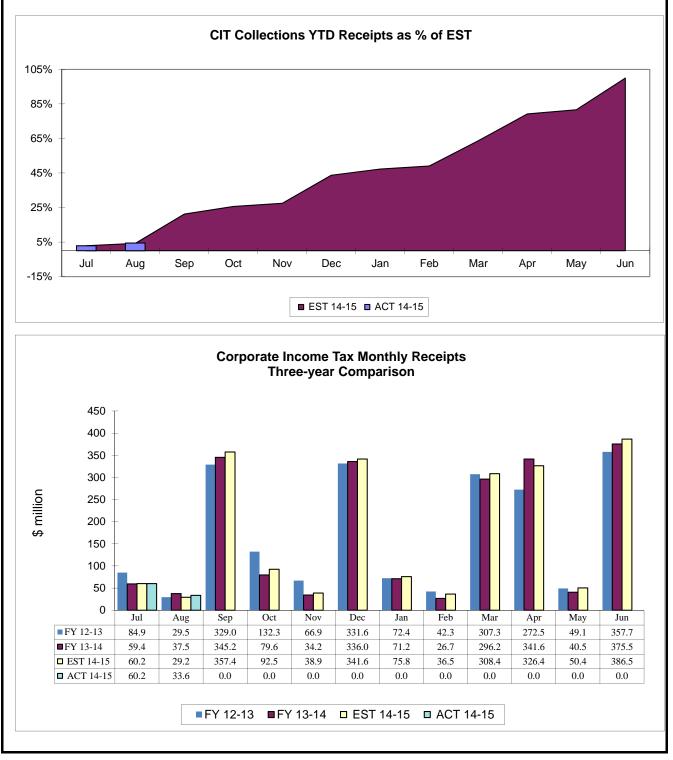

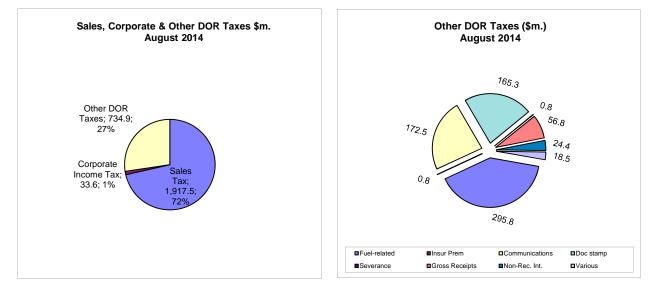
#### CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

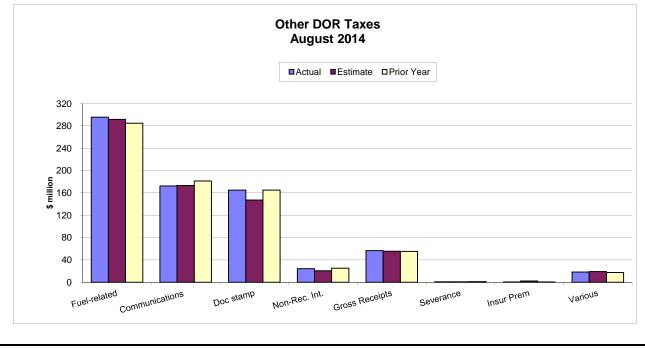
.... Collections of \$33.6m were \$4.4m (15.2%) above the August estimates. The August 2014 CIT collections were \$3.9 million below the August 2013 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference.



## OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$734.9m to DOR tax collections in August, which were \$8.3m (1.1%) above the estimates. The August collections were \$3.3m (0.5%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$18.0m (12.2%) above the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in August stayed at the same level as August 2013 collections. The nonrecurring Intangible taxes in August were \$3.7m (17.8%) above the estimates. Compared to the August 2013's collections, the non-recurring Intangible taxes were 3.8% below. The August collections on Fuel Related Taxes were \$3.8m (1.3%) above the estimates. Compared to August 2013 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the August 2014 collections were \$10.9m (3.8%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$1.0m (0.5%) below the estimates. The Gross Receipt Utility collections in August 2014 were \$1.2m (2.1%) above the estimates, and were 2.8% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium tax collections were \$1.6m below the estimates in August 2014.





## **HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS**

Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in <u>August 2014</u>. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
