SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in August by \$53.6m (2.6%) and over the 2014 August collections by \$176.9m (9.2%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$32.8m in August were below the estimates by \$6.8m (17.2%) and below the 2014 August collections by \$0.7m (2.2%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were above the estimate by \$9.4m (5.3%) in August and above the 2014 August collections by \$20.3m (12.2%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN August 2015 of \$2,094.0m were \$53.6m (2.6%) above the estimates. The August Sales and Use Tax collections were \$176.9m (9.2%) above the August 2014 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.

Analysis of July collections by category...

Three categories were above the estimates in July 2015, Other Consumer Durables being the strongest (8.1%) followed by Auto-Related (3.4%) and Business Investment (2.4%). Three categoies were below the estimates, Consumer Non-Durables being the weakest (4.2%) followed by Construction (2.1%) and Tourism (1.1%). Compared to July 2014, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Other Consumer Durables being the strongest (19.9%).

Note: July 2015 sales tax collections by categories reflect June 2015 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$32.8m were \$6.8m (17.2%) below the August estimates. The August 2015 CIT collections were \$0.7 million (2.2%) above the August 2014 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$767.1m to DOR tax collections in August 2015, which were \$31.2m (4.2%) above the estimates. The August collections were \$32.9m (4.5%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$9.4m (5.3%) above the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in August were \$20.3m (12.2%) above the August 2014 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in August was above the estimate by \$0.9m (3.7%). Compared to the August 2014's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 7.7% above.

The August collections on Fuel Related Taxes were \$13.9m (4.6%) above the estimates. Compared to August 2014 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the August 2015 collections were \$20.8m (7.0%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$4.7m (3.2%) above the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in August 2015 were \$0.4m (0.7%) above the estimates, and were 6.0% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$0.4m below the estimates in August 2015.
