## SALES AND USE TAX

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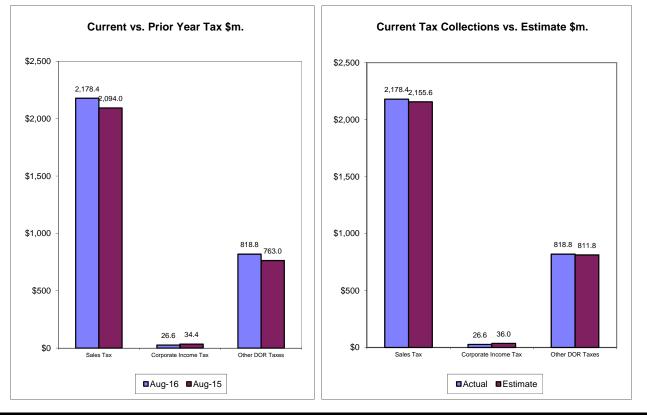
Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in August 2016 by \$22.8m (1.1%) and over the 2015 August collections by \$84.5m (4.0%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).

## CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of \$26.6m in August 2016 were below the estimates by \$9.4m (26.1%) and below the 2015 August collections by \$7.8m (22.7%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 GR conference (page 4).

## DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were below the estimate by \$3.4m (1.5%) in August 2016 and above the 2015 August collections by \$43.9m (23.5%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 GR conference (page 5).

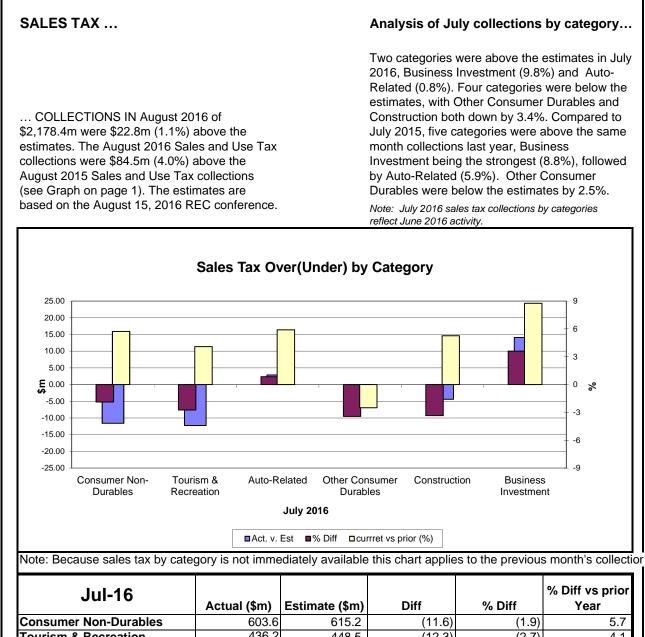

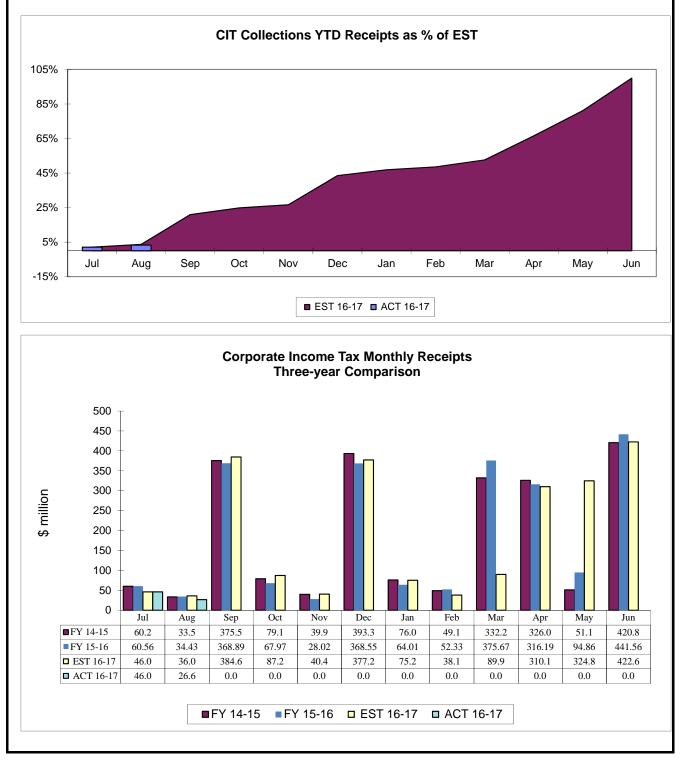

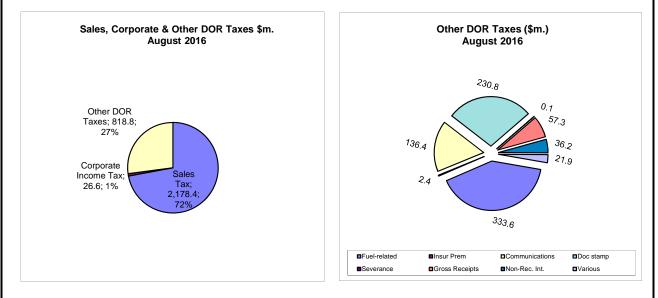
#### CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

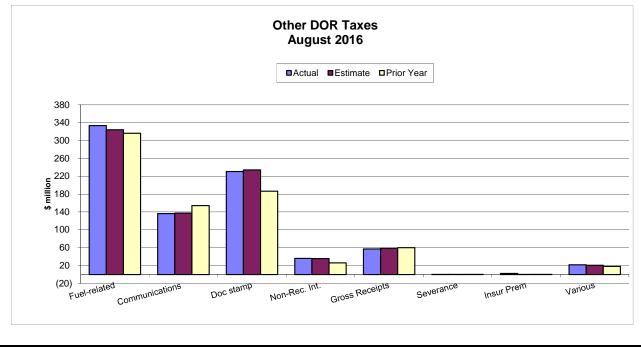
.... Collections of \$26.6m in August 2016 were \$9.4m (26.1%) below the August estimates. The August 2016 CIT collections were \$7.8m (22.7%) below the August 2015 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 15, 2016 REC conference.



## OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$818.8m to DOR tax collections in August 2016, which were \$7.0m (0.9%) below the estimates. The August 2016 collections were \$55.8 (7.3%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamp collections were \$3.4 (1.5%) below the estimates. The Doc Stamp collections in August 2016 were \$43.9m (23.5%) above the August 2015 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in August was above the estimate by \$0.4m (1.2%). Compared to the August 2015's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$10m above. The August collections of \$333.6m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$8.6m (2.9%) above the estimates. Compared to August 2015 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the August 2016 collections were \$55.8m (7.1%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$1.2m (0.9%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in August 2016 were \$1.3m (2.3%) below the estimates, and were 4.8% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$1.9m above the estimates in August 2016.





# **HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS**

Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in <u>August 2016</u>. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
