Sales and Use Tax collections were below the estimate in September by \$36.5m (1.8%) and over the 2014 September collections by \$61.0m (3.2%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$368.9m in September were below the estimates by \$31.1m (9.1%) and below the 2014 September collections by \$6.6m (1.8%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were below the estimate by \$1.9m (0.9%) in September and above the 2014 September collections by \$13.8m (7.5%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN September 2015 of \$1,965.1m were \$36.5m (1.8%) below the estimates. The September Sales and Use Tax collections were \$61.0m (3.2%) above the September 2014 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.

Analysis of August collections by category...

Four categories were above the estimates in August 2015, Auto-Related being the strongest (3.7%) followed by Tourism (3.1%) and Business Investment (2.4%). Two categoies were below the estimates, Construction being the weakest (2.9%) followed by Consumer Non-Durables (2.2%). Compared to August 2014, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Auto_Related being the strongest (10.1%) followed by Tourism (9.9%).

Note: August 2015 sales tax collections by categories reflect July 2015 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$368.9m were \$31.1m (9.1%) below the September estimates. The September 2015 CIT collections were \$6.6 million (1.8%) below the September 2014 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$797.0m to DOR tax collections in September 2015, which were \$16.5m (2.1%) above the estimates. The September collections were \$33.8m (4.4%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$1.9m (0.9%) below the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in September were \$13.8m (7.5%) above the September 2014 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in September was below the estimate by \$0.4m (1.3%). Compared to the September 2014's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 13.7% above.

The September collections on Fuel Related Taxes were \$15.0m (4.9%) above the estimates. Compared to September 2014 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the September 2015 collections were \$22.1m (7.3%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$0.7m (0.5%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in September 2015 were \$1.0m (1.6%) below the estimates, and were 7.8% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$2.2m above the estimates in September 2015.
