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#### SALES AND USE TAX

Sales and Use Tax collections were below the estimate in September 2017 by \$50.1m (-2.2%) and over the 2016 September collections by \$92.7m (4.4%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).

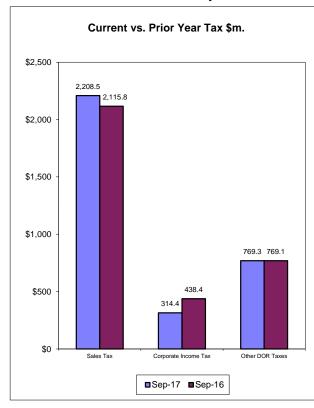
#### **CORPORATE INCOME TAX**

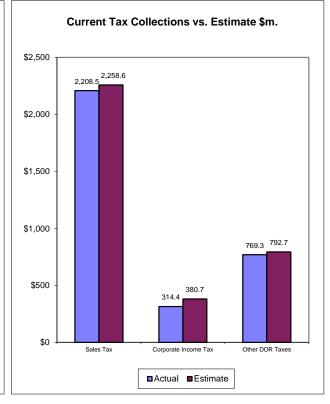
CIT collections of \$314.4m in September 2017 were below the estimates by \$66.3m (-17.4%) and below the 2016 September collections by \$124m (-28.3%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 GR conference (page 4).

#### **DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX**

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$152m were below the estimate in September 2017 by \$38.3m (-20.1%) and below the 2016 September collections by \$32.4m (-17.6%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 GR conference (page 5).

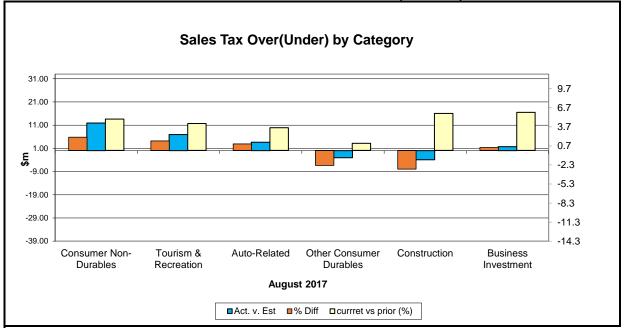
#### SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN August 2017 of \$2,208.5m were \$50.1m (-2.22%) below the estimates. The August 2017 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$92.7m (4.38%) above the August 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 REC conference.

#### Analysis of July collections by category...

Four categories were above the estimates in August 2017, Consumer Non-Durables being the strongest at 2.1%, followed by Tourism and Recreation at 1.5%. The Construction category was below the estimate at -3.0% Compared to August 2016, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Business Investment being the strongest at 6% followed by Construction at 5.8%, and Consumer Non-Durables at 4.9%.

Note: August 2017 sales tax collections by categories reflect July 2017 activity.

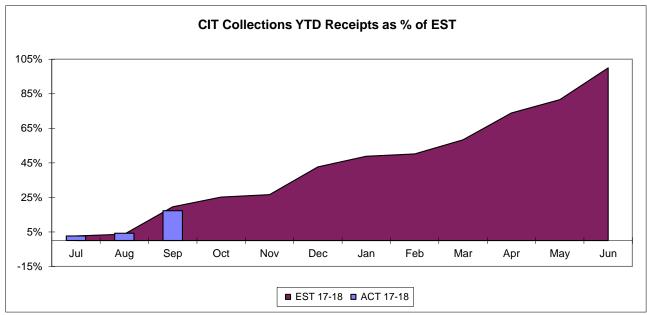


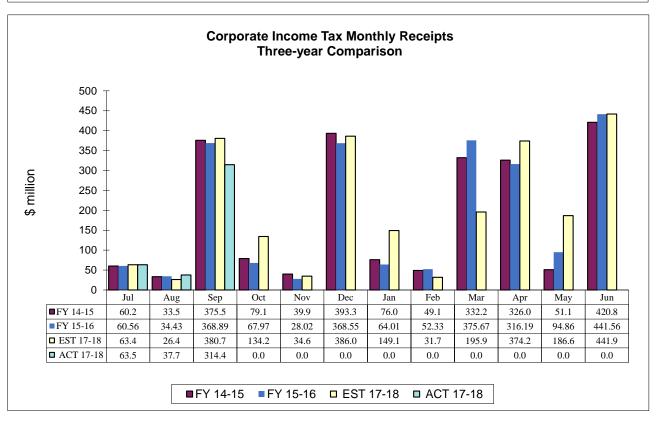

#### **CORPORATE INCOME TAX....**

.... Collections of \$314.4m in September 2017 were \$66.3m (-17.4%) below the September estimates. The September 2017 CIT collections were \$124m (-28.3%) below the September 2016 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 REC conference.

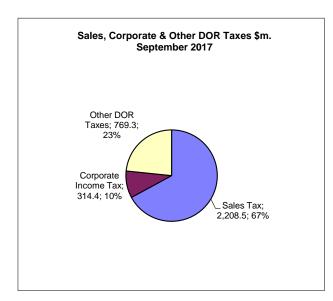


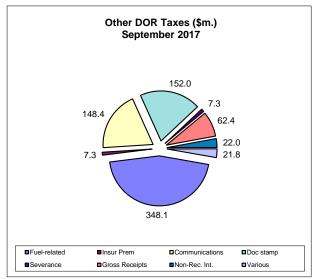


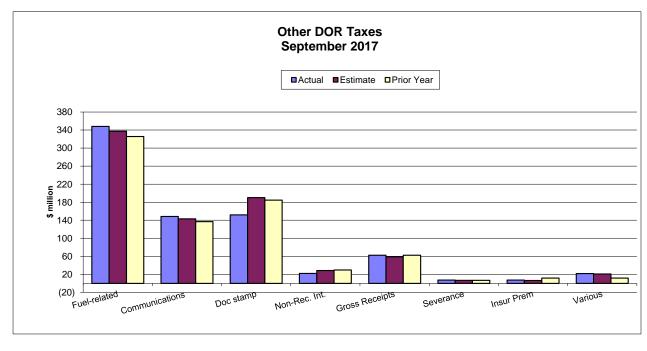
#### OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$769.3m to DOR tax collections in September 2017, which were \$23.4m (-2.9%) below the estimates. The September 2017 collections were \$0.2m (0.03%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in September 2017 were \$38.3m (-20.1%) below the estimates. The collections of the non-recurring Intangible Tax in September were below the estimate by \$6.6m (-23.2%). Compared to the September 2016's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$7.6m (-25.8%) below.

The September collections of \$348.1m on Fuel Related Taxes were \$10.6m (3.1%) above the estimates. Compared to September 2016 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the September 2017 collections were \$22.4m (6.9%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$5.2m (3.6%) above the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in September 2017 were \$3.6m (6.1%) above the estimates, and were -0.03% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$0.8m (12.6%) above the estimates in September 2017.







HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS	
Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in August 2017. These estimates	
are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
