SALES AND USE TAX

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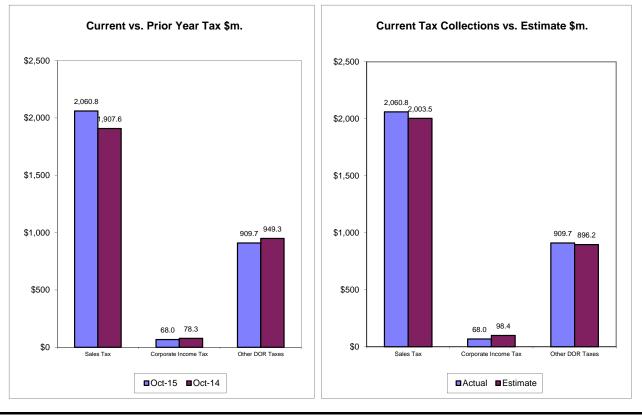
Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in October by \$57.3m (2.9%) and over the 2014 October collections by \$153.5m (8.0%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).

CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of \$68.0m in October were below the estimates by \$30.4m (30.9%) and below the 2014 October collections by \$10.3m (13.1%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were above the estimate by \$5.0m (2.8%) in October and above the 2014 October collections by \$15.3m (8.9%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 5).

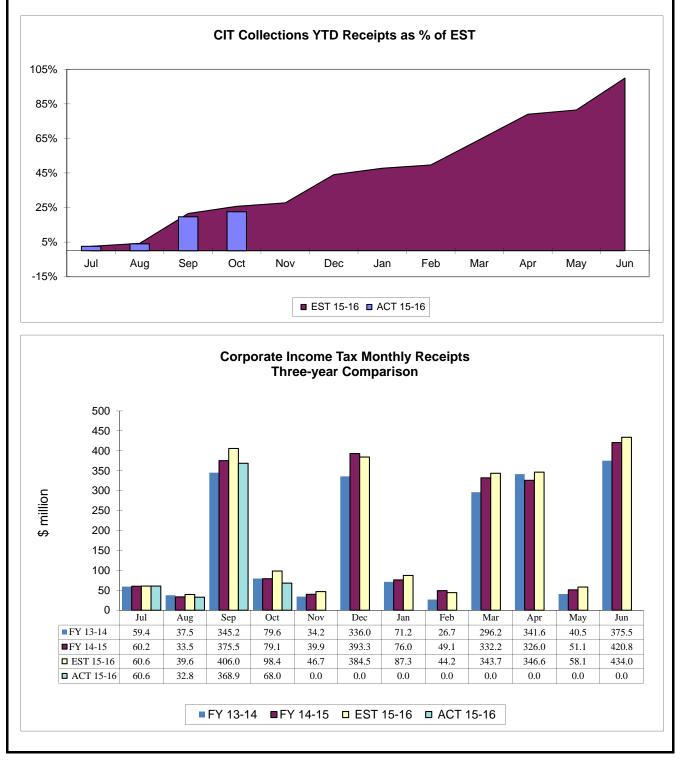

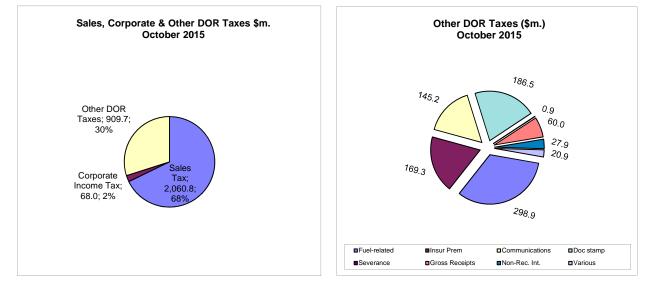
CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

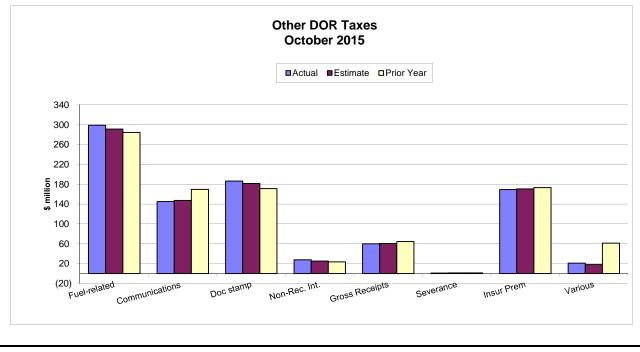
.... Collections of \$68.0m were \$30.4m (30.9%) below the October estimates. The October 2015 CIT collections were \$10.3 million (13.1%) below the October 2014 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.



OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$909.7m to DOR tax collections in October 2015, which were \$13.5m (1.5%) above the estimates. The October collections were \$39.6m (4.2%) below the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$5.0m (2.8%) above the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in October were \$15.3m (8.9%) above the October 2014 collections. The nonrecurring Intangible Tax in October was above the estimate by \$2.6m (10.4%). Compared to the October 2014's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 18.5% above. The October collections on Fuel Related Taxes were \$7.8m (2.7%) above the estimates. Compared to October 2014 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the October 2015 collections were \$14.4m (5.1%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$2.3m (1.6%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in October 2015 were \$0.8m (1.3%) below the estimates, and were 7.2% below the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$1.4m (0.8%) below the estimates in October 2015.





HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS

Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in <u>August 2015</u>. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
