### **SALES AND USE TAX**

Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in November 2017 by \$123.4m (5.4%) and over the 2016 November collections by \$269.1m (12.7%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR) (page 3).


### CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$60.4m in November 2017 were above the estimates by \$25.8m (74.5%) and above the 2016 November collections by \$23.9m (65.3%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 GR conference (page 4).

### **DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX**

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$182.2m were below the estimate in November 2017 by \$7.5m (4.0%) and below the 2016 November collections by \$21.5m (10.6%). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 GR conference (page 5).


### SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN November 2017 of \$2,389.8m were \$123.4m (5.4%) above the estimate. The November 2017 Sales and Use Tax collections were \$269.1m (12.7%) above the November 2016 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 GR conference.

### Analysis of October collections by category...

All categories were below the estimates in October 2017, with Other Consumer Nondurables at 4.5% below, Tourism & Rec. 6.4% below, Auto-Related 10.9% below, Other Consumer Durables 14.6% below, Construction 5.5% below and Business Investment 6.8% below the estimate. Compared to October 2016, two categories were above the same month collections last year, Construction at 3.4% above the previous year followed by Consumer Nondurables at 2.0% above.

Note: October 2017 sales tax collections by categories reflect September 2017 activity.






### **CORPORATE INCOME TAX....**

.... Collections of \$60.4m in November 2017 were \$25.8m (74.5%) above the November estimates. The November 2017 CIT collections were \$23.9m (65.3%) above the November 2016 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 15, 2017 GR conference.








### OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$784.3m to DOR tax collections in November 2017, which were \$0.7m (0.1%) below the estimates. The November 2017 collections were \$6.1m (0.8%) below the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in November 2017 were \$7.5m (4.0%) below the estimates. Compared to November 2016 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the November 2017 collections were \$21.5m (10.6%) below.

The collections of the Communications Services Tax in November were below the estimate by \$6.5m (4.3%). Compared to November 2016 collections on Communication Services Tax, the November 2017 collections were \$10.2m (7.7%) above. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes & Fees in November were above the estimate by \$6.5m (2.0%). The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$2.3m (8.0%) below.







HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS	
Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in August 2017. These estimates	
are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.
