SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in December by \$7.5m (0.4%) and over the 2014 December collections by \$130.7m (6.4%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).


CORPORATE INCOME TAX


CIT collections of \$368.5m in December were below the estimates by \$16.0m (4.1%) and below the 2014 December collections by \$24.8m (6.3%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 4).

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were below the estimate by \$17.4m (7.9%) in December and above the 2014 December collections by \$8.5m (4.3%). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference (page 5).


SALES TAX ...

... COLLECTIONS IN December 2015 of \$2,173.6m were \$7.5m (0.3%) above the estimates. The December Sales and Use Tax collections were \$130.7m (6.4%) above the December 2014 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.

Analysis of November collections by category...

Three categories were above the estimates in November 2015, Auto-Related and Tourism being the strongest (2.2%) followed by Business Investment (0.7%). Three categories were below the estimates, Construction category was the weakest (3.2%). Compared to November 2014, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Auto-Related being the strongest (9.7%) followed by Tourism (7.9%) and Construction (6.8%).

Note: November 2015 sales tax collections by categories reflect October 2015 activity.






CORPORATE INCOME TAX....

.... Collections of \$368.5m were \$16.0m (4.1%) below the December estimates. The December 2015 CIT collections were \$24.8 million (6.3%) below the December 2014 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 14, 2015 REC conference.





OTHER DOR TAXES...

...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$766.1m to DOR tax collections in December 2015, which were \$28.9m (3.6%) below the estimates. The December collections were \$12.5m (1.7%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$17.4m (1.9%) below the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in December were \$8.5m (4.3%) above the December 2014 collections. The non-recurring Intangible Tax in December was below the estimate by \$5.5m (16.7%). Compared to the December 2014's collections, the non-recurring Intangible Tax was 4.7% below.

The December collections on Fuel Related Taxes were \$12.4m (4.2%) above the estimates. Compared to December 2014 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the December 2015 collections were \$19.3m (6.6%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$17.6m (10.9%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in December 2015 were \$1.6m (3.1%) above the estimates, and were 9.5% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium Tax collections were \$0.2m above the estimates in December 2015.
